




In September 2016, the Fine-Art Photography Association (FAPA) will hold the third Daikanyama Photo Fair. The Japanese galleries, bookstores, and publishers that have supported the fair since its inception will be joined by leading figures in fine art photography from around the world to exhibit a carefully selected presentation of art photography.
